CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

1. Videotaping notification and release: This event could be filmed by parents or coaches. The footage gained may be used for public display on the web, for advertising the results and performances of the players. All parents/guardians of entrants are asked to sign below granting permission for the entrant to be filmed. If, for any reason, the entrant does not wish to be videotaped this will be strictly respected, but the event organisers must be informed prior to the event.

As the legal parent/guardian of the entrant named on this entry form I grant permission for the entrant to be videotaped playing during the event and understand the footage may be used for display on the web in promoting the Championships.

2. The Championships will be held under the ITTF Laws of Table Tennis and Regulations for International Competitions and TTA Regulations for National Junior Championships.
3. Butterfly 3 star 40 mm white balls will be used for all events. Stiga blue tables will be used.
4. Each match will be controlled by an umpire whose decision shall be final on point of fact. The Referee's decision will be final on point of law.
5. All competitors must be financial and registered members of an affiliated State or Territory Association or a registered member of an Association affiliated with ITTF.
6. Doubles matches will be best of 5 games. Singles matches will be best of 5 games in the round robin, and then best of 7 games in the knock out.
7. All competitors in Under 18 events must have been born on or after 1 January 1991.
All competitors in Under 15 events must have been born on or after 1 January 1994.
All competitors in Under 13 events must have been born on or after 1 January 1996.
8. The first round of the Under 18 Singles events (events 1, 2) will be played as three person groups. The first round of the Under 15 and Under 13 Singles events (events 6, 7, 11 and 12) will probably be played as three person groups, depending on the number of entries. All other events will be knock-out.
9. Players must umpire when directed by the Referee or the Deputy Referee.
10. Players absent when required to play will render themselves liable to disqualification from the relevant event.
11. Entries may be ignored without notification, unless accompanied by the full amount of the fees due, made on the official entry form, and duly endorsed by an official of the State/Territory Association or an Association affiliated with ITTF.
12. The main colour of a playing shirt, skirt or shorts must not be **white**. Players should be neatly dressed and not wear clothing that might cause offence or bring the game into disrepute. Nominated doubles pairs from the same Association must be dressed uniformly.
13. No claim whatsoever will be recognized should a player receive an injury during participation in the Championships.
14. Rackets must not be glued inside the playing venue.
15. A Management Committee will be appointed and will carry out the functions in terms of TTA Regulations. One of these functions is to consider any appeals against rulings of the host organisation or the Referee on a question of match or tournament conduct not covered in the Laws.
16. Complete results will be placed on www.tastabletennis.org.au/2009_aust_junior.htm, as a downloadable jpeg document, after the Championships. A results book is not being produced in an effort to reduce use of paper.
